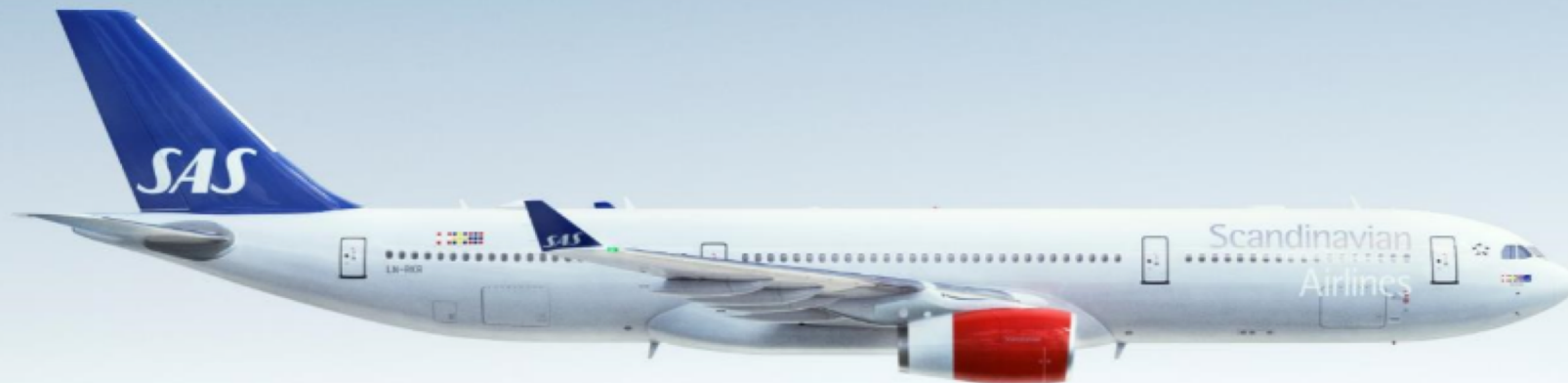

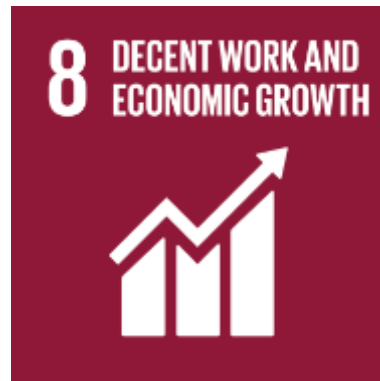


UN Sustainable development goals
